



## 2020 Utah 6 Hour Rules

NASA Utah is excited to host this round of the Western Endurance Racing Championship on the 3.1 mile Outer Loop of the Utah Motorsports Campus.

We'll be following the latest version of the NASA Endurance Racing Regulations available from [www.nasaproracing.com/rules](http://www.nasaproracing.com/rules).

Below are the supplemental rules for this event. If there is any overlap, the rules below will be followed.

- **MANDATORY DRIVER'S MEETING:** There is a **mandatory** driver's meeting Saturday 8/1 at **12:10pm at the Fast Track Café by Grid**. At least one representative from your team **MUST** attend this meeting and a maximum of two. **Driver attendance recommended.**
- **Black Flag Stations:** Stations showing black flag for individual cars/drivers will be T-5, T-11, and Start.
- **Pit Space Assignments:** NASA Utah will assign pit spaces in the Endurance Driver's meeting. Teams may not be given a choice of space. Teams will however, be allowed to [make a request](#) to pit next to other teams or cars and we will try to accommodate their requests. GP garage rentals will include one pit space *near* the garage IF your team fills out the request form.
- **Fuel:** UMC provides fuel at their pumps, from 85-110 octane ratings, credit cards are accepted. NO E85 is available at the facility.
- **Fueling:** All fueling must be done on pit lane in accordance with the NASA Endurance Racing Regulations.
- **Fuel Containers:** We will allow standard, unmodified, auto parts store style 5 gallon fueling containers for fueling. If you question whether yours is legal, please verify with race director.
- **Car Lights:** Please verify that all of your required lighting works prior to the start of the race. We had many lighting issues in 2019.
- **Penalties:** Will be served by the "Timed" method as outlined in the Endurance Racing Rules.
- **Tire Disposal:** UMC no longer provides tire disposal, all tires must be hauled off premises. Any team found leaving tires on-site will be billed \$10 PER TIRE for disposal.
- **CREW:** All crew must report to the NASA Utah office before the race to sign the waiver and get a crew wristband. Nobody will be allowed on pit lane without a wristband.
- **IMPORTANT LINKS:**
  - [Team/Driver Declaration \(Mandatory\)](#) – Each team must have 1 of these filled out by **7/30**
  - [Pit Space Request \(Optional\)](#) – If you have rented a GP Garage and want your pit space near it, or if you're sharing crew with another team and need to be collocated, please let us know.
  - [Tow Fund \(Optional\)](#) - Thanks to a generous grant from the Tooele Tourism Tax Board, we have a tow fund available of \$175 per car to the first 25 teams from outside Tooele County that apply for it.

## 2020 Utah 6 Hour Rules (Cont.)

### COVID RULES:

- Nose and Mouth coverings are 100% required. These will need to be worn whenever you are in public areas. You will not need to wear these in your vehicles, or if sitting alone in your paddock space. These can be a homemade mask, a bandana, a balaclava, etc., but they need to be able to stay on your face while you use your hands. You will need to provide these yourselves.
- Friends and Family are invited! They will need to follow the same rules about masks and social distancing as all drivers.
- UMC is requiring temperature to be taken at the front gate to enter the facility. This will happen each time you enter the gate.
- All participants will need to practice social distancing, and all paddock parking will need to be done with this in mind.
- Day garages will only be allowed to house 1 vehicle (parked in the middle. GP garages will only be allowed to house 2 vehicles (nose to tail)
- Registration by credit/debit card only. No cash
- No BBQ and Awards ceremony
- [Read the NASA National Policy](#) – Some of our policies will be more restrictive because of Utah State, and UMC guidelines.
