- Be to Grid 10 minutes before your schedule says your run group is scheduled. A sign board adjacent to grid will communicate which group is on track, and which should be in grid!
- We are not responsible if you miss your session. Watch the grid board, and the schedule to stay on rotation!

## DRIVERS MEETINGS

## COVID Rules

Subject to update from NASA Utah officials, the following restrictions are in-place:

- Friends and family are welcome but please abide by the rules outlined below to help maintain a safe environment for all drivers so we can continue to host events!
- Unvaccinated participants should wear a cloth mouth and nose face covering or other non-venting PPE mask when in public areas such as at meetings, Driver Info and Registration, vendor areas and food lines, photography viewing areas, pregrid, fan stands and track viewing areas, "communal" rental garages, and vehicle tech inspection. Drivers do not need to wear a mask or face covering while in their vehicles.
- Unvaccinated participants should continue to maintain 6 feet social distancing. Face coverings are not a substitute for physical/social distancing.
- Vulnerable individuals to COVID-19 (those greater than 74 years old, and those with serious underlying medical problems such as hypertension, diabetes, obesity, chronic lung disease and asthma, or immunocompromised state) should take extra care to protect themselves, such as RNA vaccination or strict social distancing and protective (KN95 or N-95) masking if unvaccinated. Non-vulnerable participants need to understand that there is risk of bringing the virus home from any event and should take extra caution to isolate from vulnerable individuals once back home.
- When the term "unvaccinated" is used below, it includes individuals who are not two weeks post vaccination with the J&J vaccine or the second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine and those who have not recovered from Covid-19 in the prior 90 days.
- No BBQ and Awards ceremony - You may stop by the NASA office Saturday and/or Sunday afternoon to collect your medal.
- Participants who are sick or coughing should not go to the event and will be required to leave.

## RACERS RULES

- First and foremost, remember that this is Club Racing. Everyone wants to have fun, but we all want to be able to drive our cars off track and return to race again.
- Please refresh your memory of the rules
- Is your classing complete and uploaded? It needs to be! If your paperwork is not uploaded you will not be eligible for contingency or finishing position.

- If you are being unsafe on track, we will black flag you.
- **Start your VIDEO!** If you are in an incident and do not have video, you will be penalized.
- Session times will be in Racehero app. We will post times on office window as well.
- Qualifying grid positions will be based on the warm-up and practice sessions from that morning.
- Race grids will be posted on Racehero. know your position before driving towards grid for your race!
- Look to the sign board in grid for who is on track and who should be in grid.
- **Report ALL contact!** You have 30 minutes from end of session to turn in a body contact form to Tech. Please include your SD card taped to your form, and approximate location in paddock where we can find you as needed.
- After sessions watch for Impound notice and Car #s from Pit Out staff
- For impound, please stay in your car unless asked to get out.
