



2026 Utah Endurance Supplemental Rules

We'll be following the latest version of the NASA Endurance Racing Regulations available from members.drivenasa.com/rules.

Below are the supplemental rules for this event. If there is any overlap, the rules below will be followed.

- **MANDATORY DRIVERS MEETING:** There is a **mandatory** drivers meeting for each endurance race, Location and Time will be listed on the schedule. **At least one representative from your team MUST attend this meeting. Penalty will be announced in drivers meeting.**
- **Black Flags:** Corner stations showing black flag for individual cars/drivers will be Turn-5, Turn-11, and Start Stand.
- **Live Timing:** Live timing will be available on the Speedhive App
- **Pit Space Assignments:** Come to drivers meeting with your desired pit space number. Please note, these numbers do not directly match GP garage numbers.
- **Pit Space Equipment:** UMC provided extinguishers do NOT count towards the minimum equipment required in each pit space. Please leave UMC extinguishers on the pit lane wall.
- **Cleanup:** Please clean up your pit space, garages, and paddock area before leaving. No tape or other marking should remain on pit lane.
- **CREW:** All crew must report to the NASA Utah office before the race to sign the waiver and get a crew wristband. Nobody will be allowed on pit lane without a wristband.
- **Fuel:** UMC has 91, 100, and 110 (leaded), but we cannot guarantee quantities.
- **Fueling:** All fueling must be done on pit lane in accordance with the NASA Endurance Racing Regulations. DO NOT FUEL in garages or paddock.
- **Fuel Containers:** We will allow standard, unmodified, auto parts store style 5 gallon fueling containers for fueling. If you question whether yours is legal, please verify with race director.
- **Car Lights:** Please verify that all your required lighting works prior to the start of the race. We do ask that all teams adjust forward-facing lights in a manner to not blind cars ahead of them.
- **Penalties:** Will be served by the "Lost Laps" method as outlined in the Endurance Racing Rules.
- **Tire Disposal:** UMC DOES NOT provide tire disposal, all tires must be hauled off premises. Any team found leaving tires on-site will be billed \$50 PER TIRE for disposal.
- **Fuel Barrel Disposal:** UMC does not provide fuel barrel disposal. If you are caught leaving a fuel barrel on-site NASA Utah will charge you the price of disposal plus \$100.
- **PODIUM/TROPHIES:** We'll do medals on pit lane right after the race.
